National Transit News

SWTA Annual Conference

More than 500 transit professionals gathered at the Gaylord Rockies Resort & Convention starting February 22 through February 25, 2023. SWTA hosted their Annual Conference & Expo in Aurora, Colorado presenting attendees with the education, networking, and a trade show featuring products and services.

SWTA's mission is to strengthen its member's ability to provide public transportation and mobility services across the region through education, community, and advocacy. The regional transit association serves eight states throughout the south, including Arizona, Arkansas, Colorado, Kanas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, New Mexico, and Texas. Leaders from six out of the eight state transit associations in the SWTA Nation were in attendance at the annual convention.

Thirty-one Federal Transit Administration staff, five Regional Administrators and three Deputy Regional Administrators were in attendance at the event. Additionally, staff from APTA and CTAA attended, along with representatives from the Departments of Transportation from Colorado, New Mexico, and Texas. The SWTA Nation was able to bring together representatives from one hundred five transit agencies across twenty-two states. An additional one hundred forty-seven companies participated in the event as exhibitors, sponsors, and attendees.

A highlight from the event came from a keynote address delivered by FTA Administrator Nuria Fernandez. She highlighted the FTA's role as a provider of technical assistance to grantees. This is especially important in 2023, as we focus on converting the resources provided by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law into more opportunities for people to travel by transit.
